The **Marilyn G. Williams Circle** will meet on Monday, November 13 at 6 p.m. in the Ben. F. Williams Classroom.

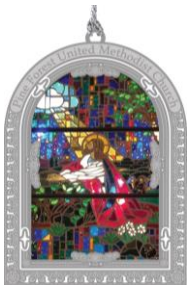


ADVENT DEVOTIONALS NEEDED
